BEFORE the Live Seminar

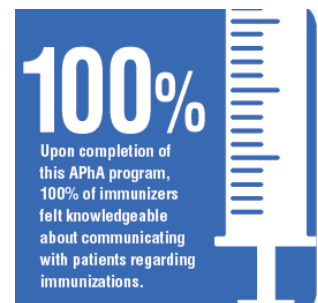
- 1) **Complete the Pre-Assessment** – Short assessment which gauges your knowledge prior to studying the material
- 2) **Complete the self-study modules, injection video, self-study assessment, and evaluation** – The self-study will require approximately 12 hours to complete
- 3) **Claim the credit** – Within 12 hours, you will be able to view/download your transcript of CPE from your CPE Monitor profile at www.nabp.net

- 4) **Print slides and worksheets to bring to class** – There is no guarantee that these materials will be provided on site.

DAY of Live Seminar

- 1) **Attend Live Seminar**
- 2) **Notate deadline to redeem Attendance Code**

AFTER the Live Seminar

- 1) **Log into www.pharmacist.com**, click through **Learn, My Training**, and click on title of program
- 2) **Redeem Attendance Code and Complete Evaluation** – Evaluation will be for live program and instructors
- 3) **Complete Final Assessment** – You will have two opportunities to take and/or pass the assessment
